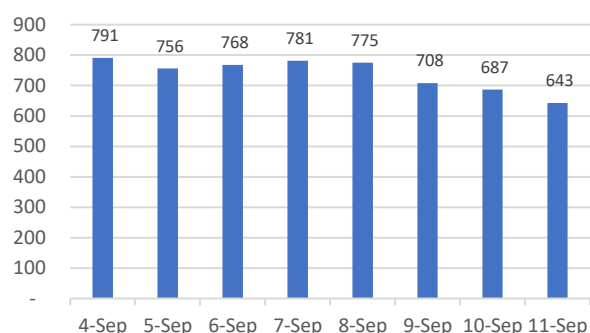

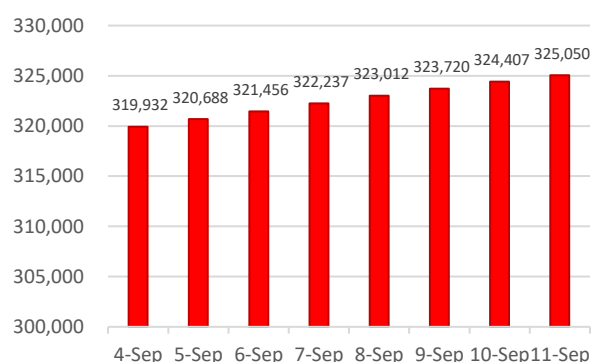
HIGHLIGHTS

- In 2 days : 43% of the new cases were female and 10% children.
- Cities with highest new infections were: Jeddah (174), Makkah (170), Dammam (138), Hufuf (137), Madinah (125), Riyadh (110), Al Qatif (97) and Hail (72).
- The UN General Assembly adopted a draft resolution calling for the coordination of a practical global response to combat the Covid-19 pandemic.
- A third Taa'kaad centre starts providing services in Riyadh at Al Faysalia Area.
- COVID-19 recovery reaches 92.9%.
- 5 players from Al-Hilal sport club are infected with Corona.

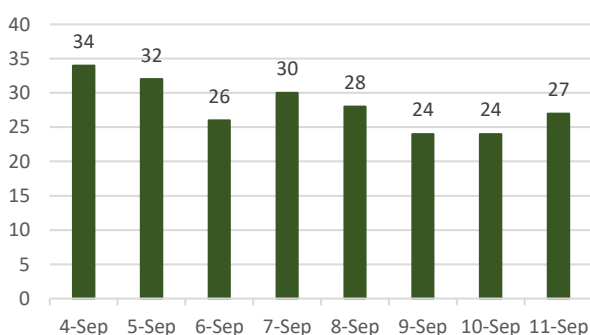
Number of New Cases
