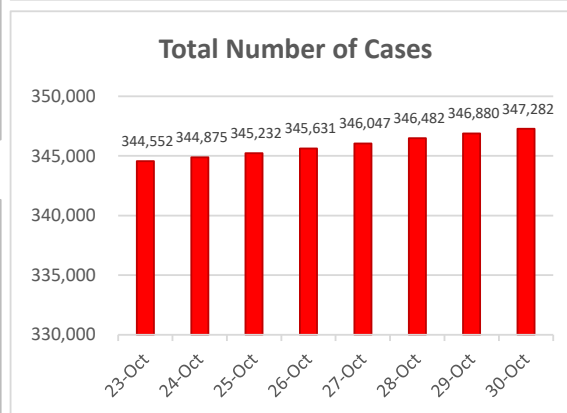
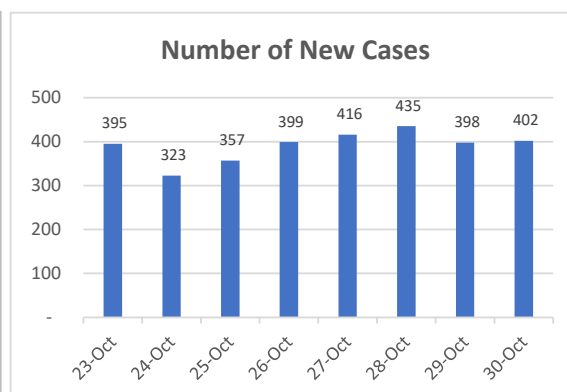

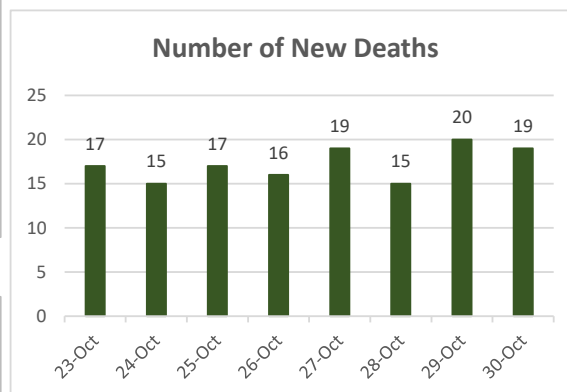
HIGHLIGHTS

- 42% of the new cases are female and 11% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections over the past 3 days: Madinah (154), Riyadh (143), Makkah (110), Yanbu (95), Hail (63), Jeddah (59), Khamis Mushait (54), and Hufuf (32).
- The beginning of the third phase of resumption of Umrah service starts today, 20,000 Umrah pilgrims and 60,000 worshipers will be allowed to enter Grand Mosque on a daily basis.
- 19,500 visitors will have permits to visit the grave of Prophet Muhammad in Madinah starting today.
- Riyadh's King Khalid International airport became the 2nd airport in the Middle East to acquire the Health Accreditation certificate.
- Launching of an application to book vehicles electronically at the Grand Mosque in line with the preventive measures.
