## HIGHLIGHTS

- Cities with highest new infections: Madinah (72), Makkah (49), Riyadh (37), Yanbu (22), Jeddah (18), Hufuf (15), Arar (9) and Bllsamar (8).
- Citizens of the GCC should obtain Umrah permits or to visit the Prophet's Mosque and Al-Rawda Al-Sharifa through the application of E'atmarna; have a PCR less than 72 hours before entering the Kingdom; and have precautionary isolation for 3 days on arrival.
- Ministry of Health publishes a complete file of information and questions on the seasonal flu.

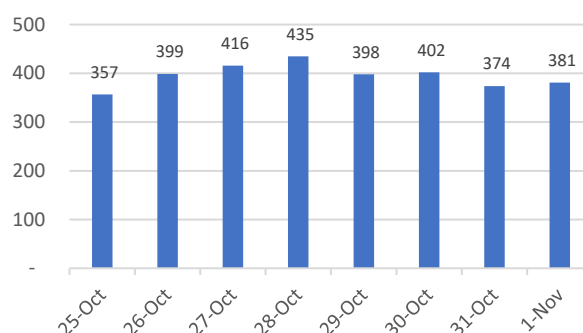

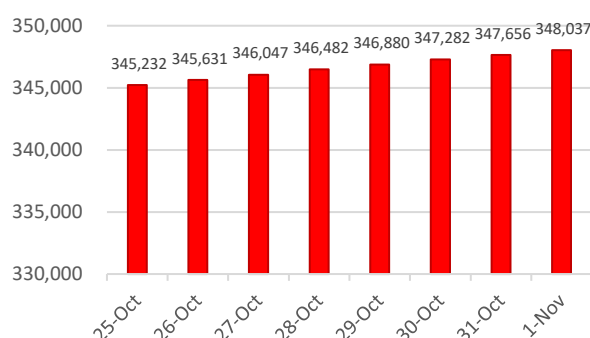
