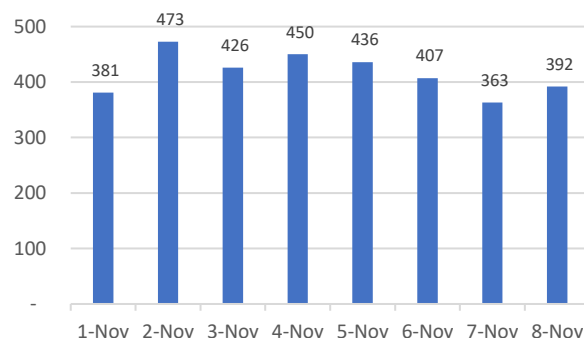

## HIGHLIGHTS

- 39% of the new cases are females and 11% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections: Madinah (59), Riyadh (54), Makkah (32) Yanbu (28), Jeddah (22), Hail (19), Hufuf (16), Buraidah (9) and Dammam (7).

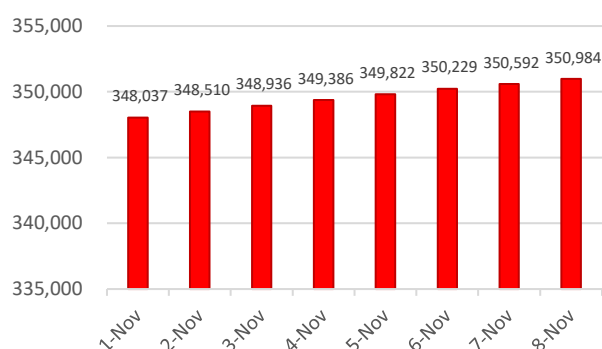
Number of New Cases

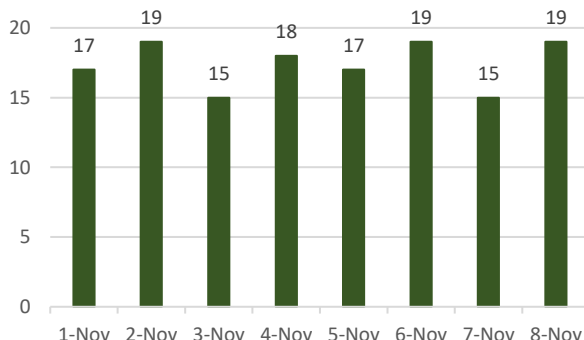
Total Number of Cases



## IMPORTANT DEFINITIONS

**Definition of a Contact:** A contact is a person who has experienced any one of the following exposures during the 2 days before and the 14 days after the onset of symptoms of a probable or confirmed case: **1.** face-to-face contact with a probable or confirmed case within 1 metre and for at least 15 minutes; **2.** direct physical contact with a probable or confirmed case; **3.** direct care for a patient with probable or confirmed COVID-19 disease without using recommended personal protective equipment; OR **4.** other situations as indicated by local risk assessments.
