

# Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

## Situation Report No. 21 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia



Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 4 April 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

- Out of a total of 2,179 confirmed cases, a total of 420 recovered and were discharged and 4 died;
- The recorded deaths were: 1 female citizen in Madinah; and three expatriates, one in each of Makkah, Madinah and Jeddah;
- Out of the new cases 2 were travel related, and 138 were contacts of cases;
- Distribution of new cases: 66 in Riyadh, 21 in Jeddah, 15 in Hufuf, 9 in Makkah and the remaining cases are distributed in 14 other localities;
- The most affected cities since the beginning of the epidemic are: Riyadh (666), Makkah (372), Jeddah (328), Madinah (235), Dammam (139), and Qatif (128);
- The curfew in some neighbourhoods in Jeddah has been extended to become a 24 hour curfew, with time allowed for purchasing necessities and seeking healthcare from 6 am to 3pm;

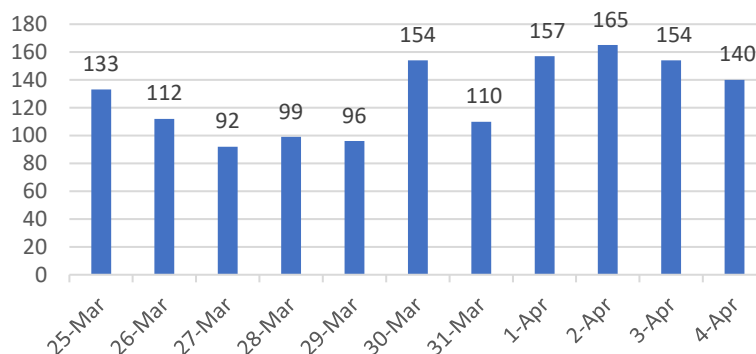
