Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 07 June 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- 3,045 new cases bringing total to 101,914. Of the new cases, 55% were Saudis, 34% females and 12% children.
- 1,026 new recoveries, bringing total to 72,817.
- 36 new mortalities bringing total to 712.
- There are 28,385 active cases, 1,564 of them in critical condition.
- 25,036 PCR tests were conducted, reaching a total of 958,237.
- A Syrian doctor died from coronavirus, the Kingdom's third expatriate health worker death.
- Emir of Madinah Region launched the new mobile laboratory with a capacity of 10,000 samples daily; results are obtained in 12 hours at present.
- MoH inaugurates a 500-bed corona virus field hospital in Jeddah.
- Saudi Health Ministry says more than 160,000 people have registered as volunteers in the fight against COVID19, of which 72,000 are active.
- A new hotline (2222) is authorized for cardiopulmonary resuscitation cases.
- WHO updates guidance on the use of face masks in context of COVID-19 (see link below), and stresses that mask use is only one component of a comprehensive approach to prevent and control COVID-19 and should be adopted with hand hygiene, physical distancing and other measures.

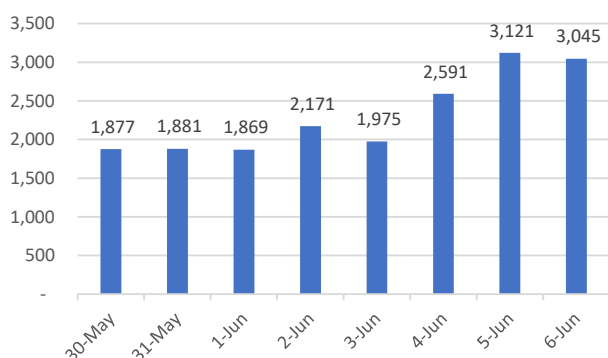

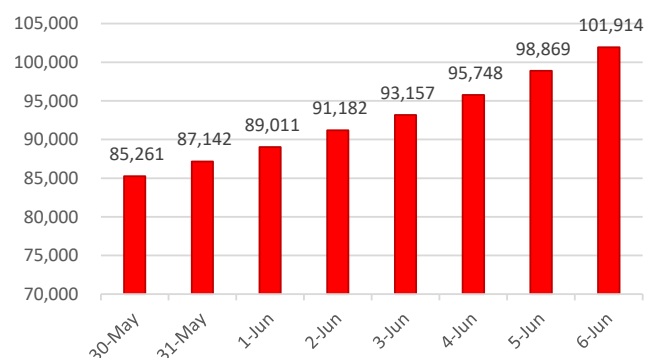
