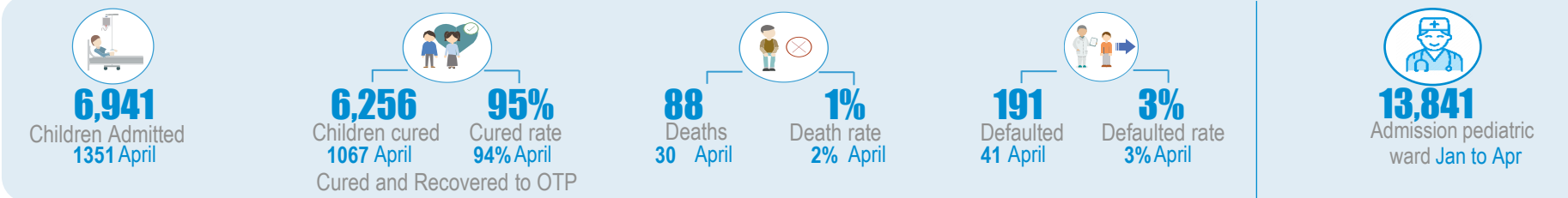

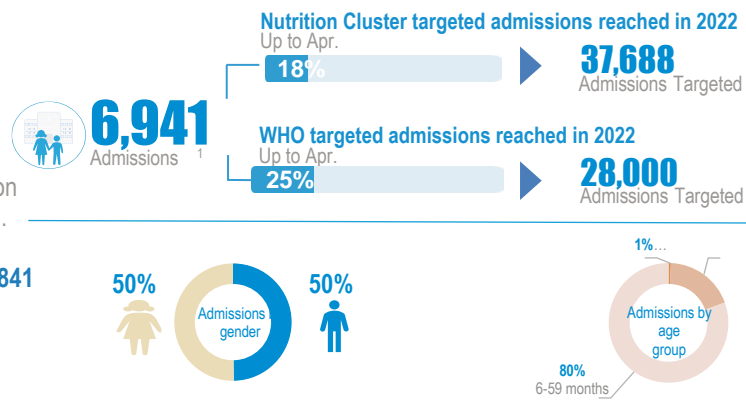


## Service Utilization January-April

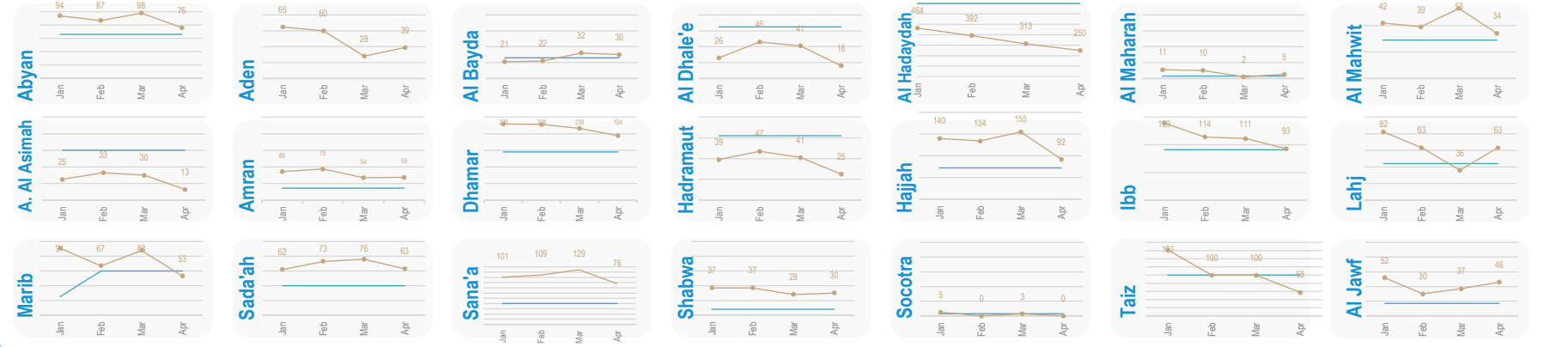
From January to April **6,941** children have received life-saving services in WHO-supported TFCs, of which **1,310 (19%)** are children under 6 months.

The quality of service is evidenced by the recovery (**95%**) and death (**1%**) rates. Each caregiver (**6,941** in total) benefits from at least 5 counselling sessions per hospital stay on IYCF best practices. This might contribute to the observed decrease in relapse rate (**2%**) in April.

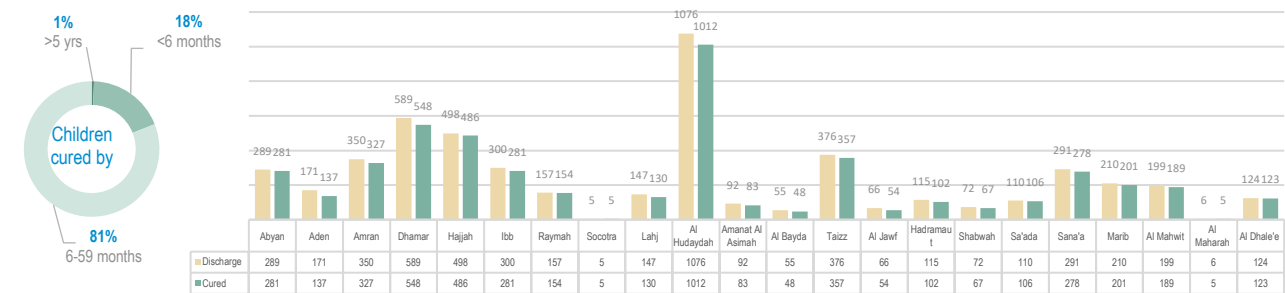
By ensuring the care for most critical cases in pediatric wards in referral hospitals with TFCs, **13,841** children were admitted from Jan - Apr in these referral hospitals for intensive care.



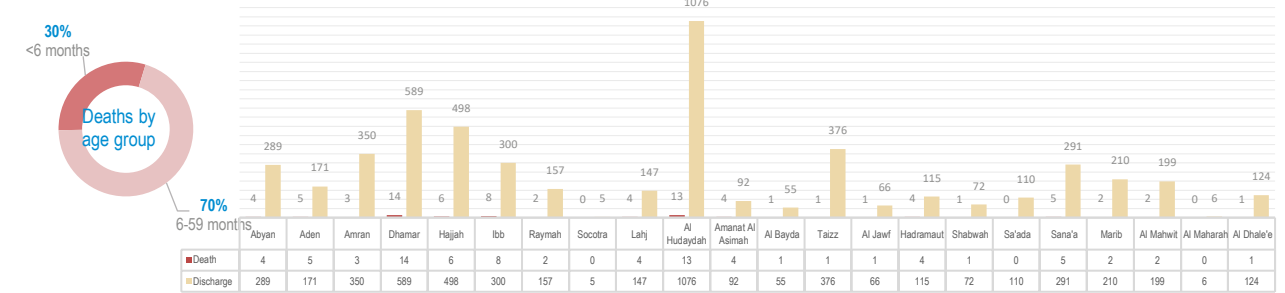
## Service Utilization per Governorate



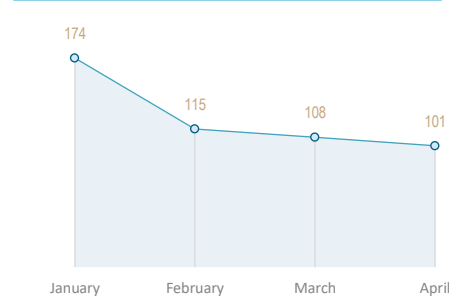
## Cured Children per Governorate in April



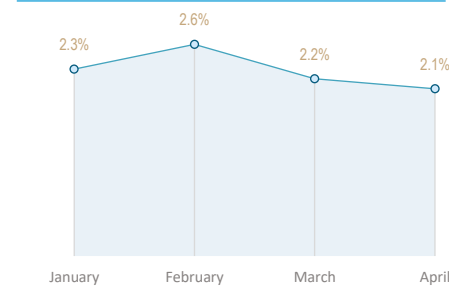
## Deaths per Governorate in April



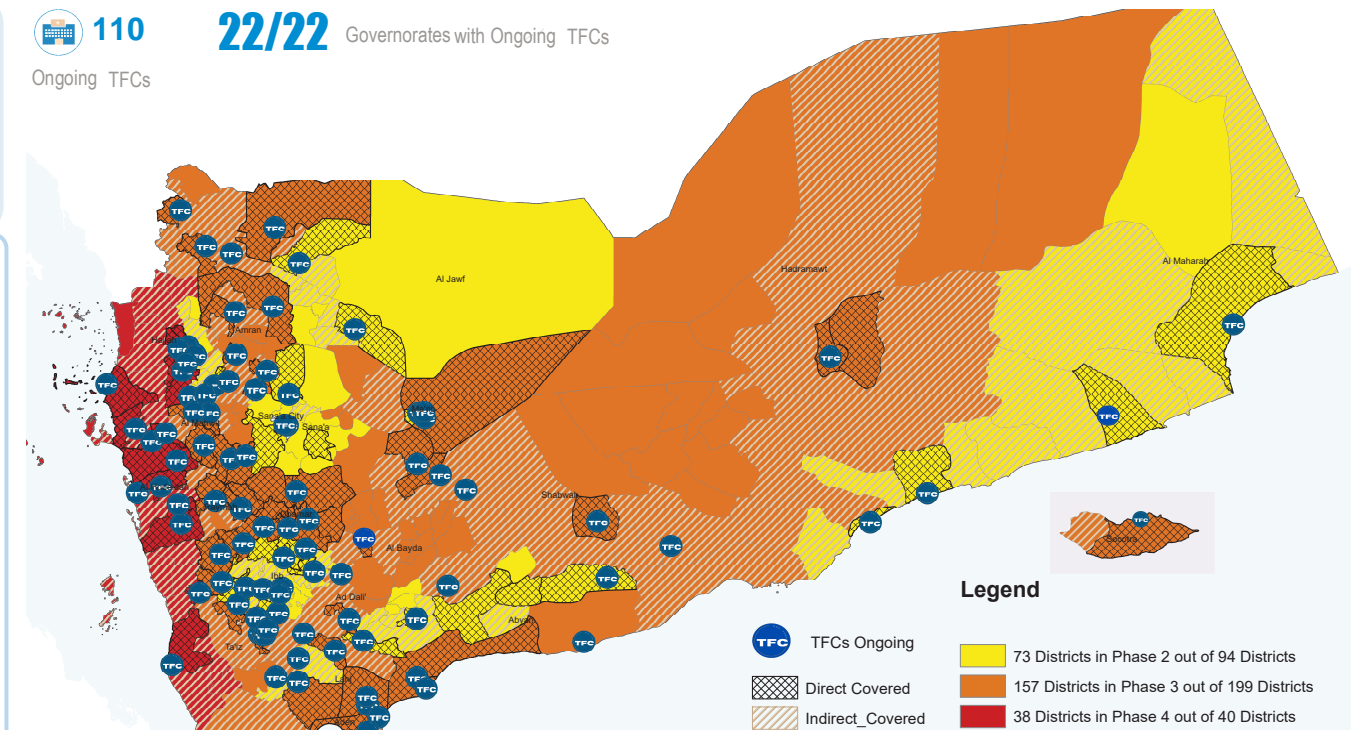

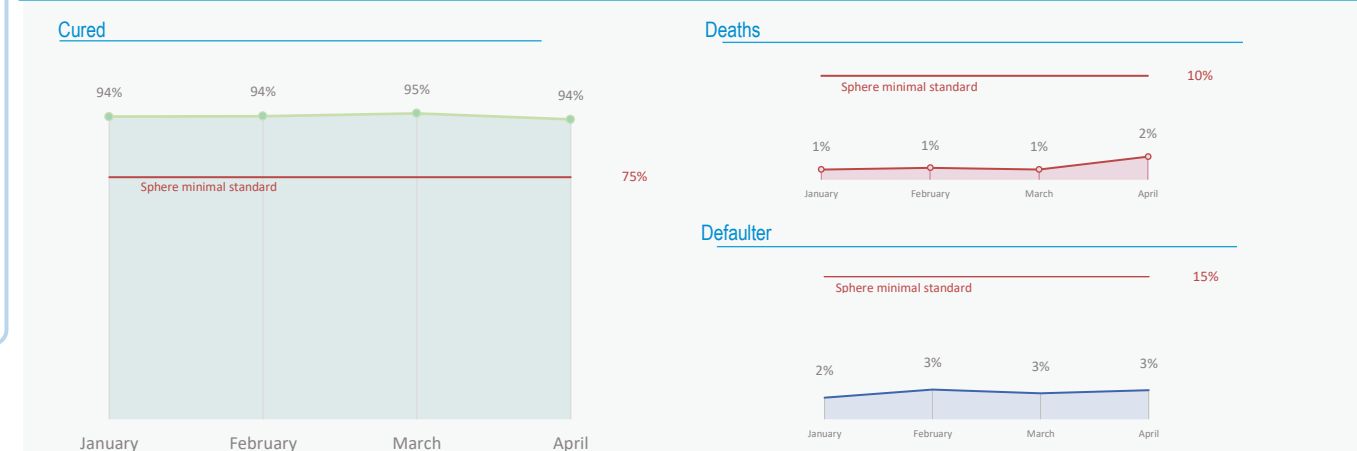
