
## Service Utilization January-May

From January to May 6,958 children have received life-saving services in WHOsupported TFCs, of which 1,528 (22%) are children under 6 months. The quality of service is evidenced by the decrease in the default rate and death rate.in May, the cured rate Reached 94%, the default rate was 4% and the death rate was only 1%.


Behind each child, a caregiver was counselled on IYCF best practices, 6,958 caregivers in total. Each caregiver received 10 counselling sessions per hospital stay. In 2021, 6,958 counselling sessions were conducted in TFCs. The increase of equitable access and utilization of quality preventive nutrition services in TFCs, such as IYCF counselling, is evidenced by the decrease in the relapse rate, at 3% on average per month, throughout the 2021.







