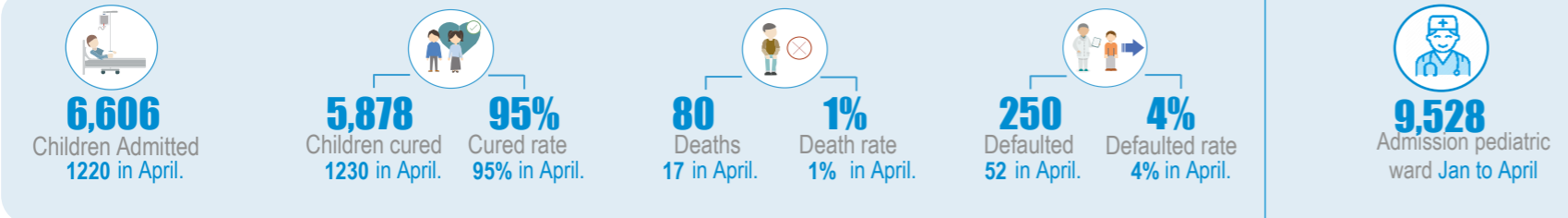

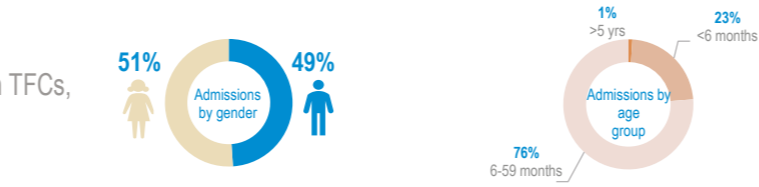
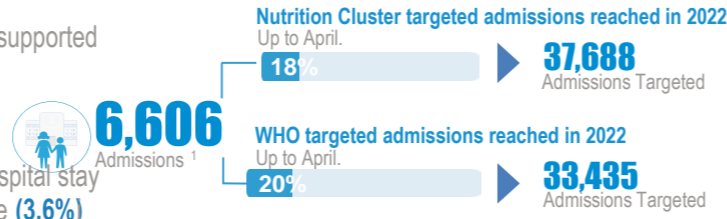


Service Utilization January-April

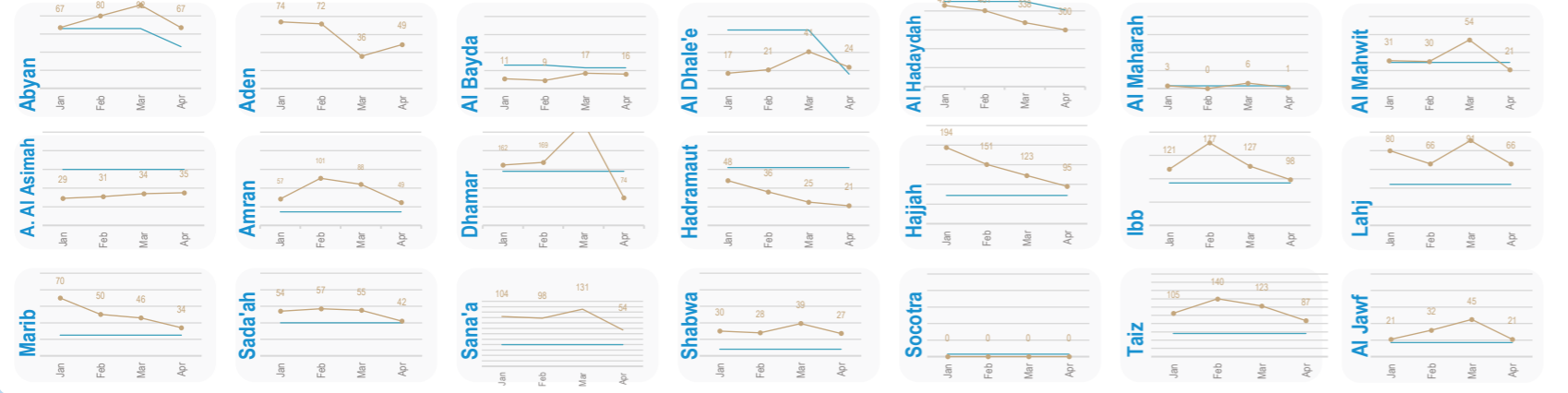
From January to April **6,606** children have received life-saving services in WHO-supported TFCs, of which **1,505 (19%)** are children under 6 months.

The quality of service is evidenced by the recovery (**95%**) and death (**1%**) rates. Each caregiver (**6,606**) in total benefits from at least 5 counselling sessions per hospital stay on IYCF best practices. This might contribute to the observed decrease in relapse rate (**3.6%**) in April

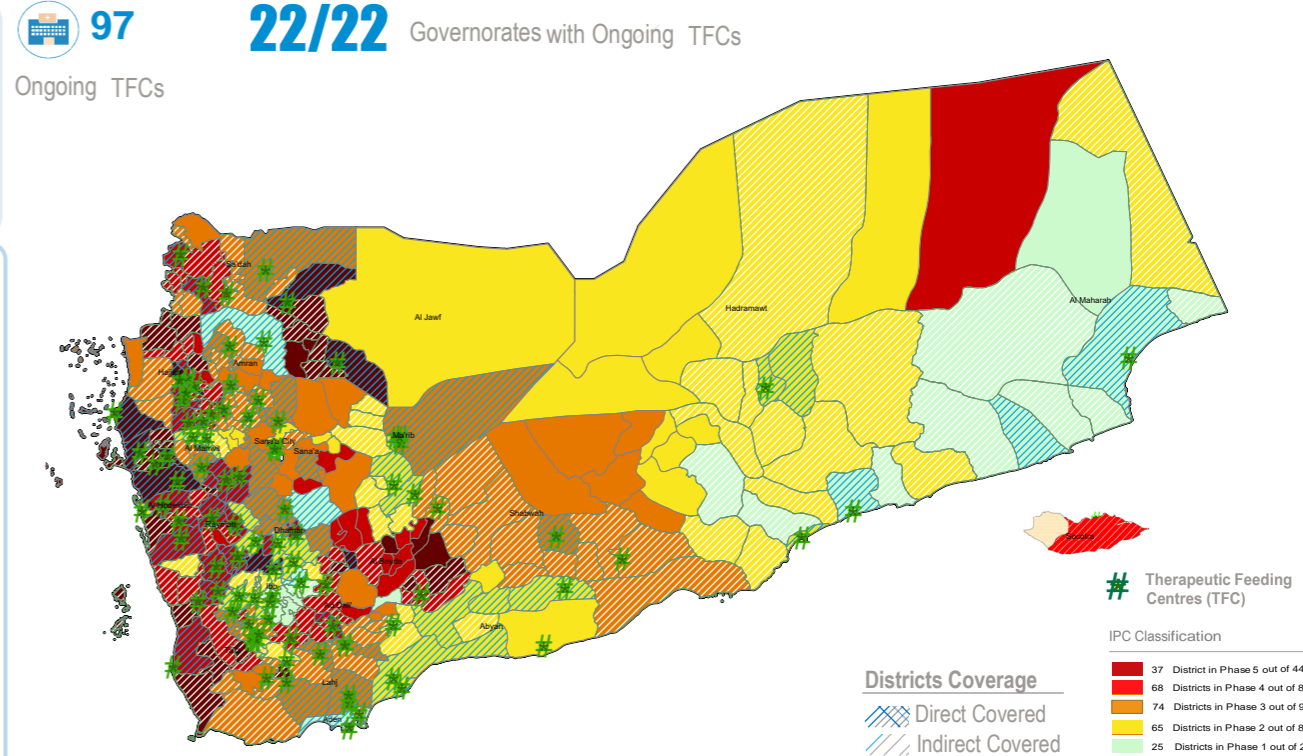
By ensuring the care for most critical cases in pediatric wards in referral hospitals with TFCs, **9,528** children were admitted Jan to April in these referral hospitals for intensive care.



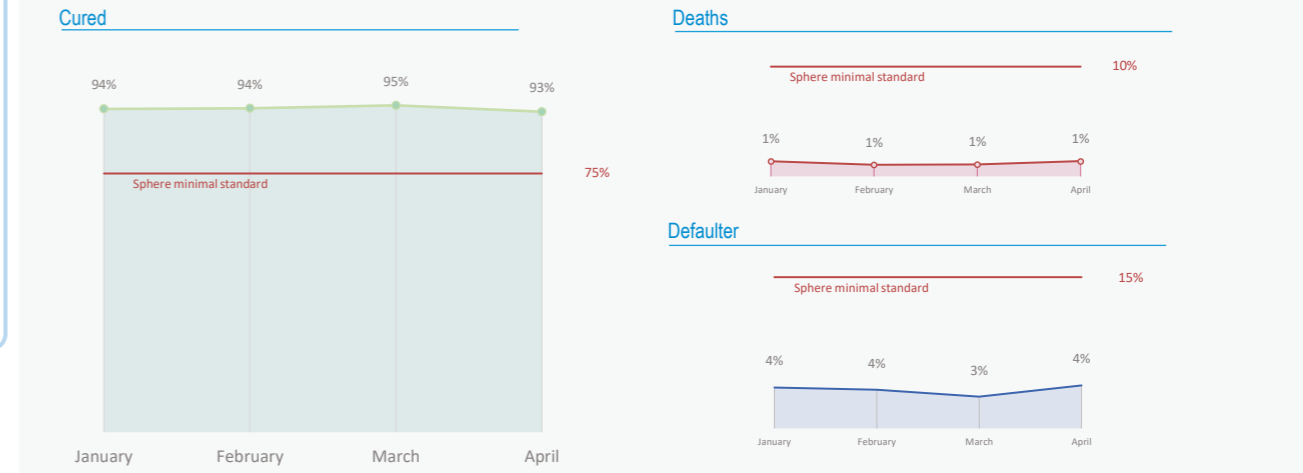
Service Utilization per Governorate



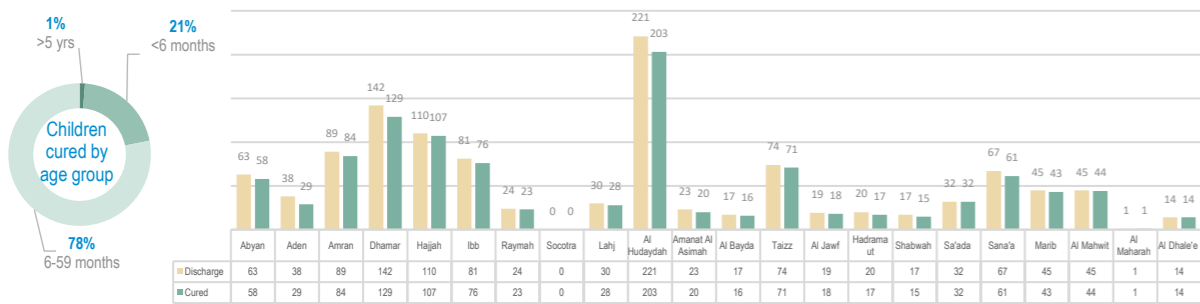
TFC Coverage by district (with IPC Classification)



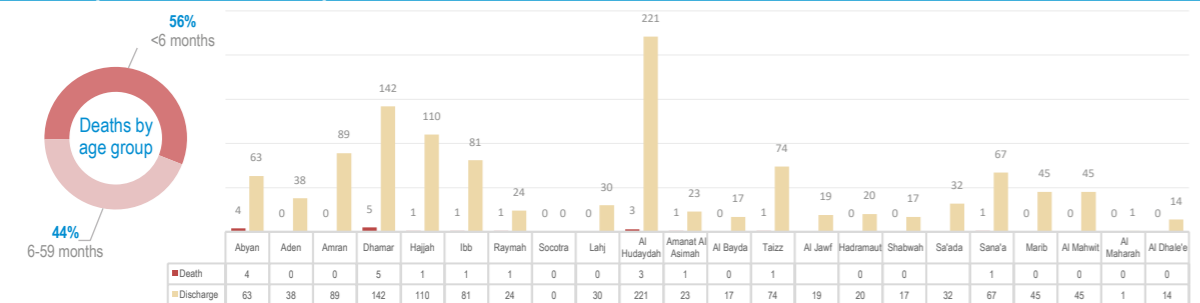
TFCs Performance Indicators January-April



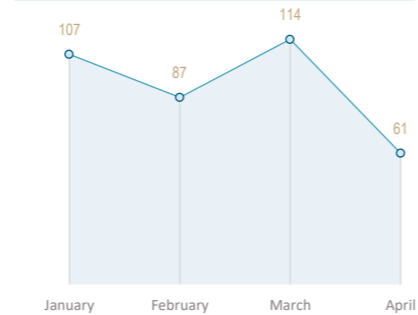
Cured Children per Governorate in April



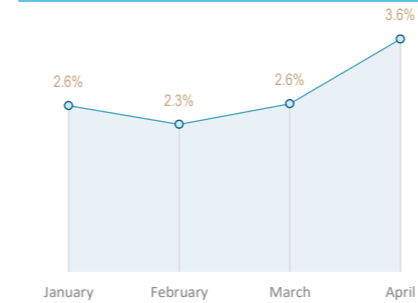
Deaths per Governorate in April
