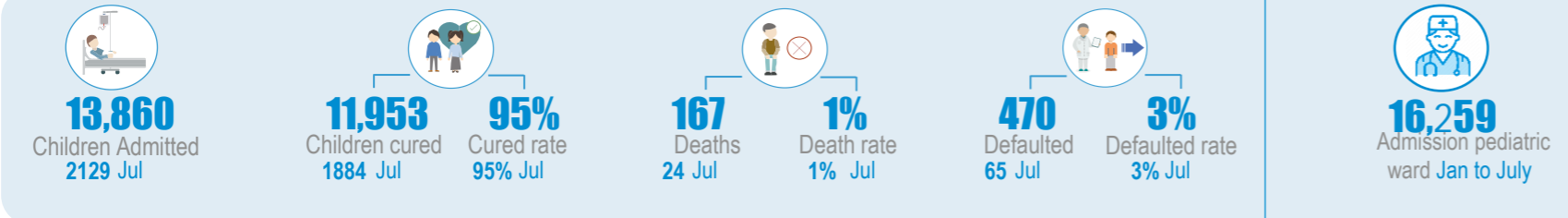

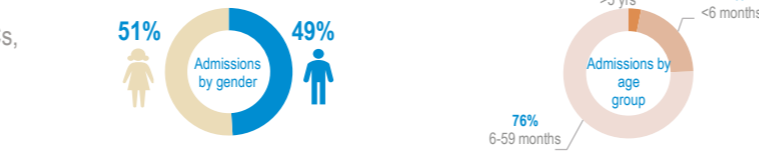
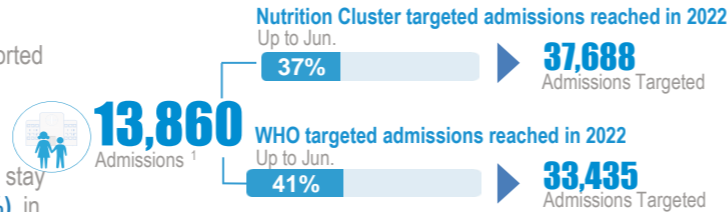


Service Utilization January-July

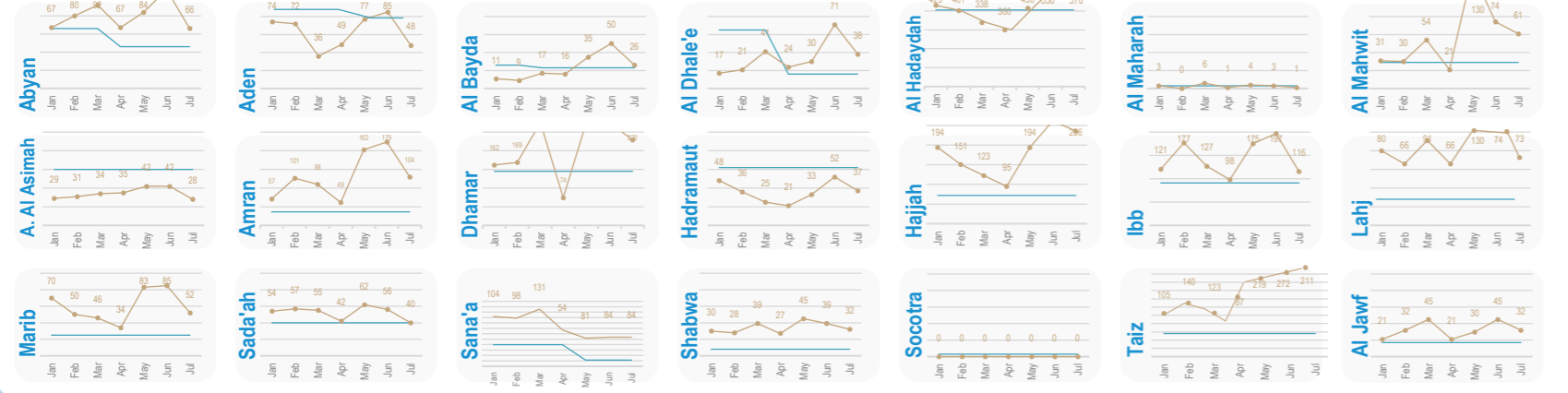
From January to July **13,860** children have received life-saving services in WHO-supported TFCs, of which **2994 (22%)** are children under 6 months.

The quality of service is evidenced by the recovery (**95%**) and death (**1%**) rates. Each caregiver (**13,860**) in total benefits from at least 5 counselling sessions per hospital stay on IYCF best practices. This might contribute to the observed decrease in relapse rate (**2%**) in October.

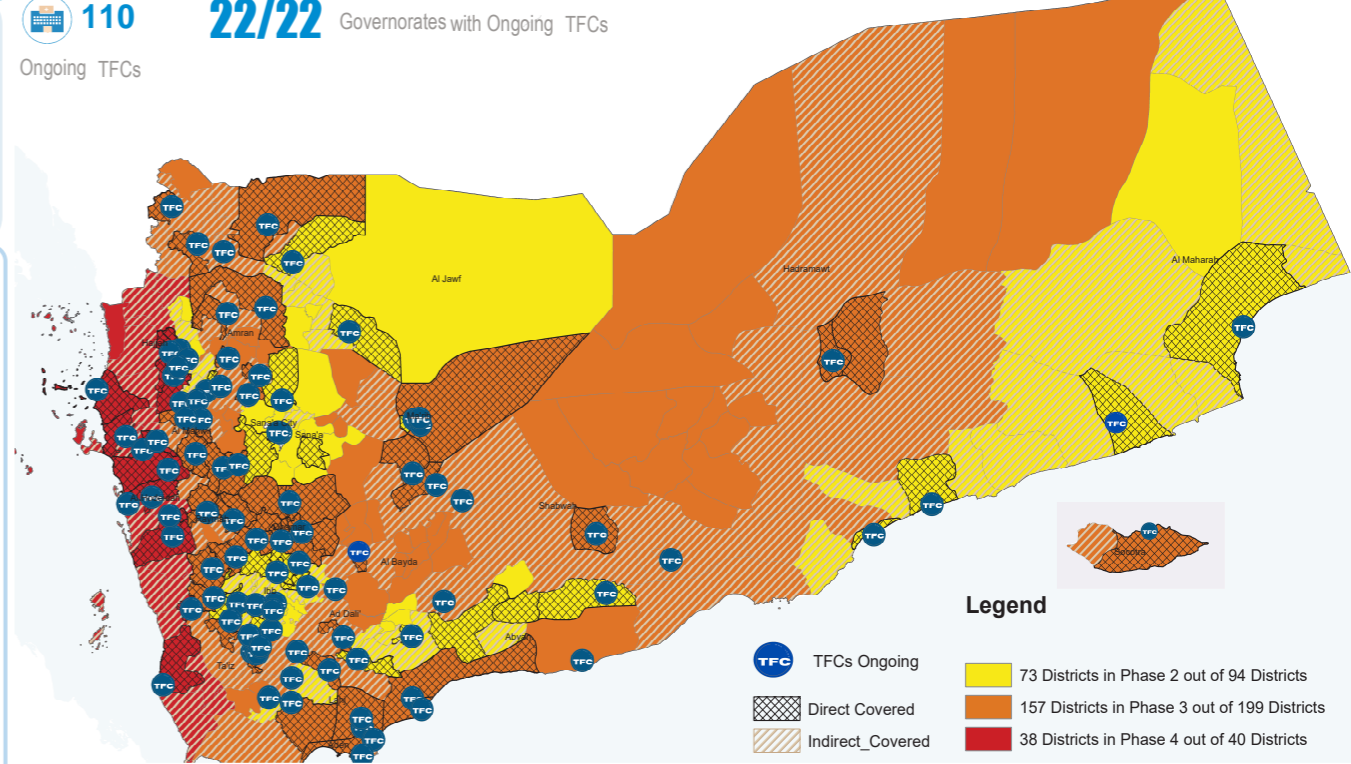
By ensuring the care for most critical cases in pediatric wards in referral hospitals with TFCs, **16,259** children were admitted in October in these referral hospitals for intensive care.



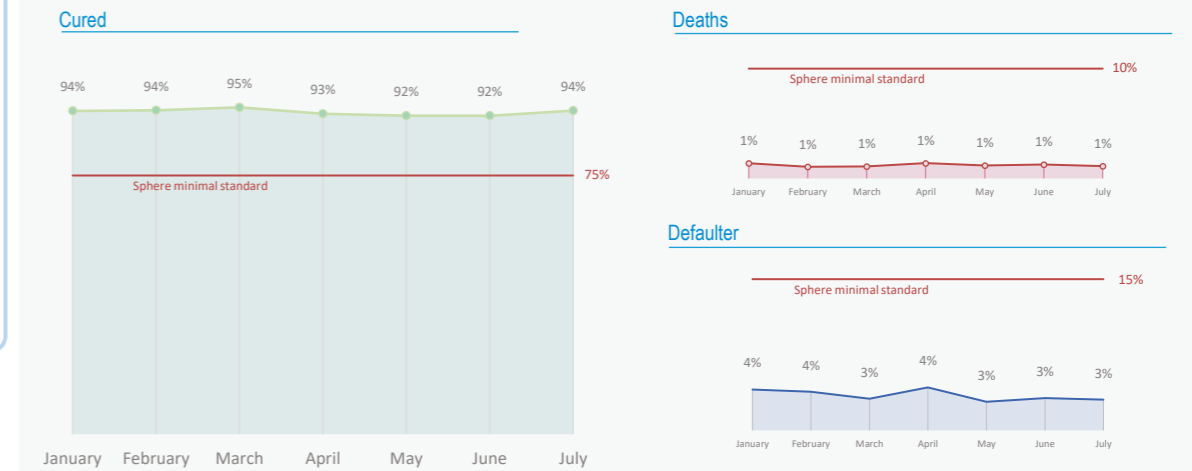
Service Utilization per Governorate



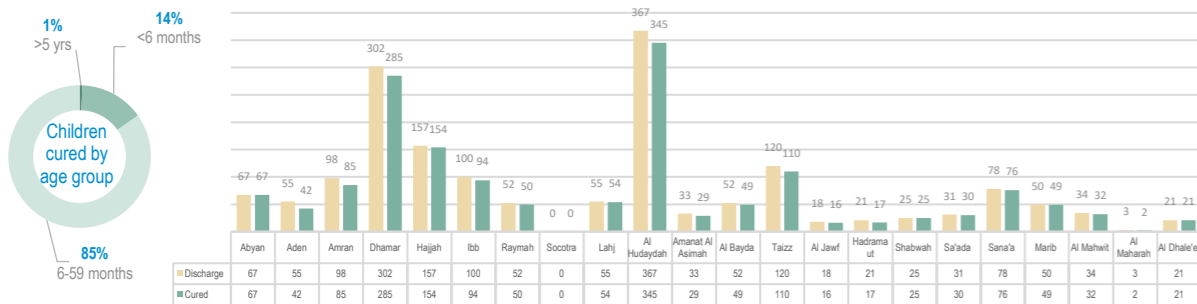
TFC Coverage by district (with IPC Classification)



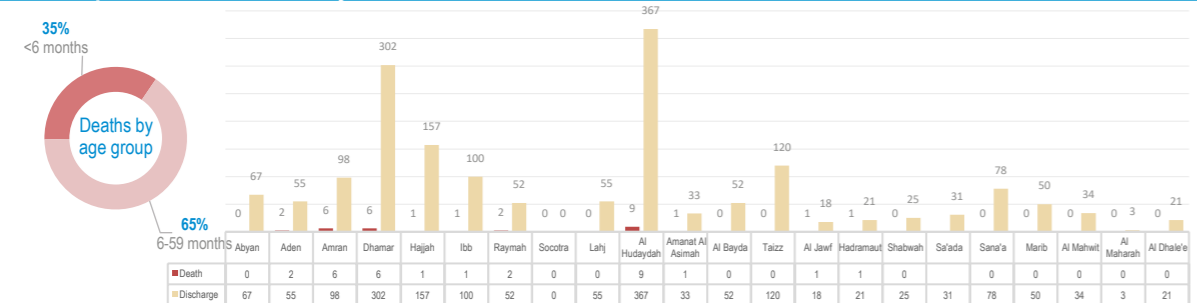
TFCs Performance Indicators January-July



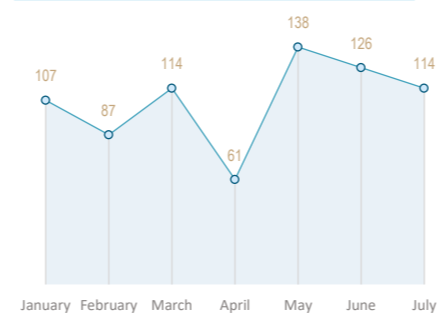
Cured Children per Governorate in July



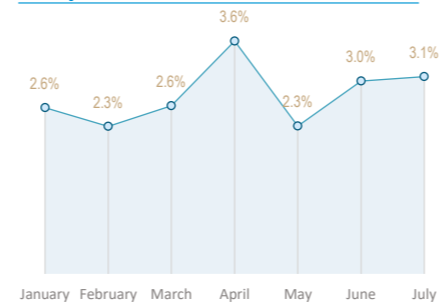
Deaths per Governorate in July
