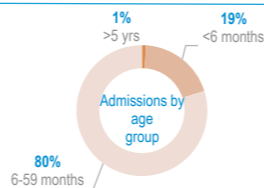
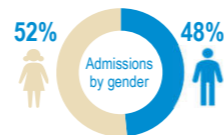
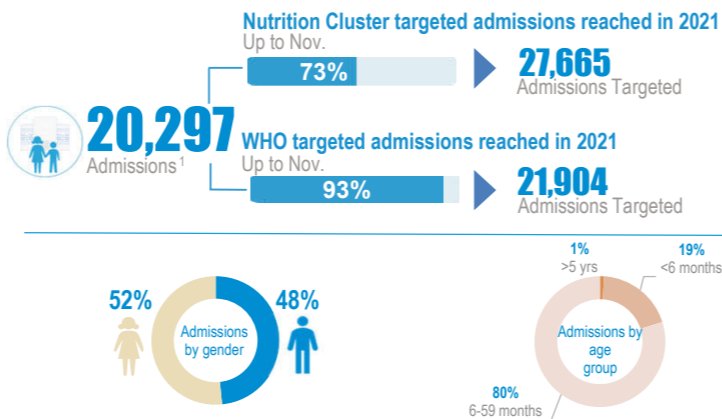


Service Utilization January-November

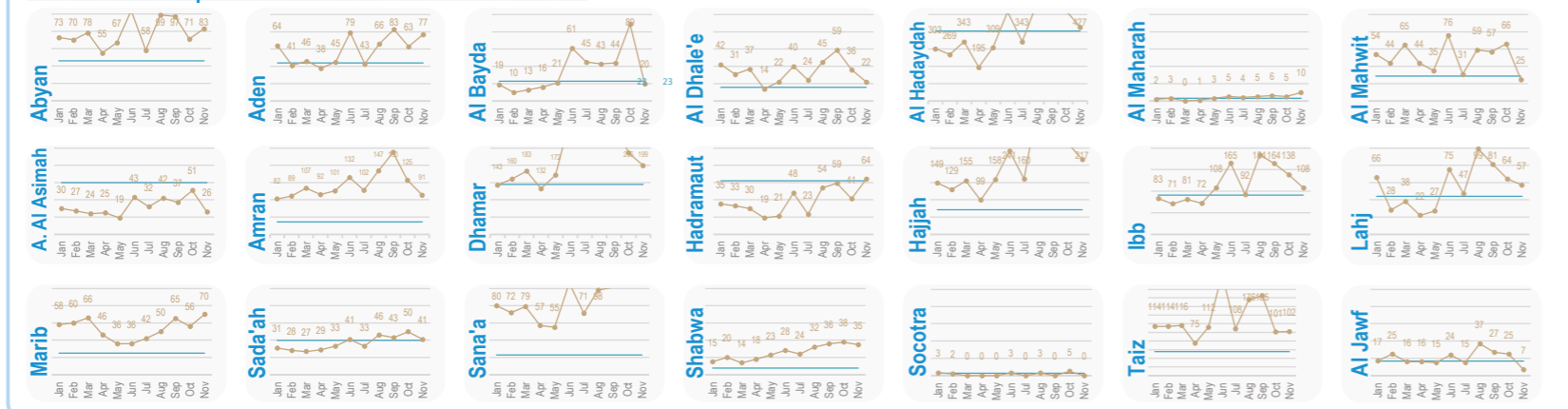
From January to November **20,297** children have received life-saving services in WHO-supported TFCs, of which **3,870 (19%)** are children under 6 months.

The quality of service is evidenced by the recovery (**94%**) and death (**2%**) rates. Each caregiver (**20,297**) in total benefits from at least 5 counselling sessions per hospital stay on IYCF best practices. This might contribute to the observed decrease in relapse rate (**2%**) in November

By ensuring the care for most critical cases in pediatric wards in referral hospitals with TFCs, **4,197** children were admitted in November in these referral hospitals for intensive care.



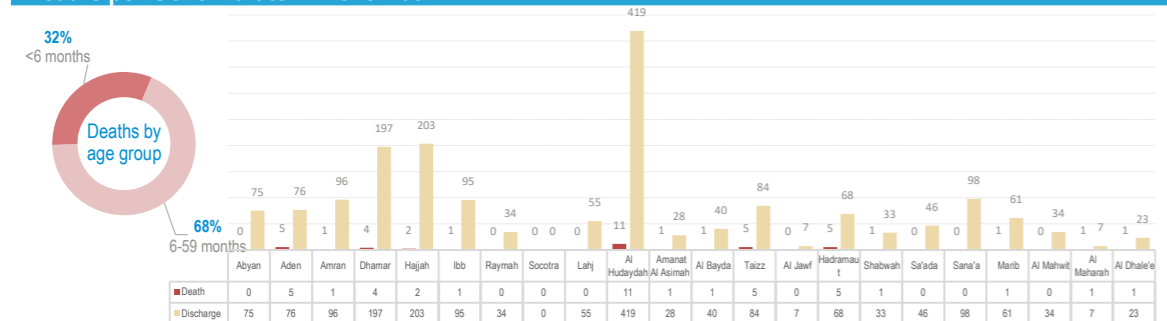
Service Utilization per Governorate



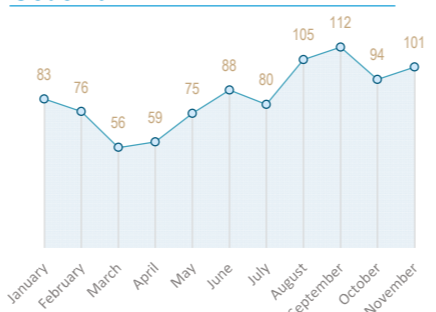
Cured Children per Governorate in November



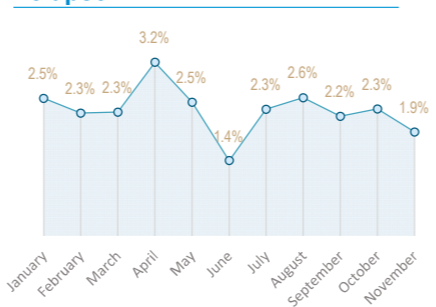
Deaths per Governorate in November



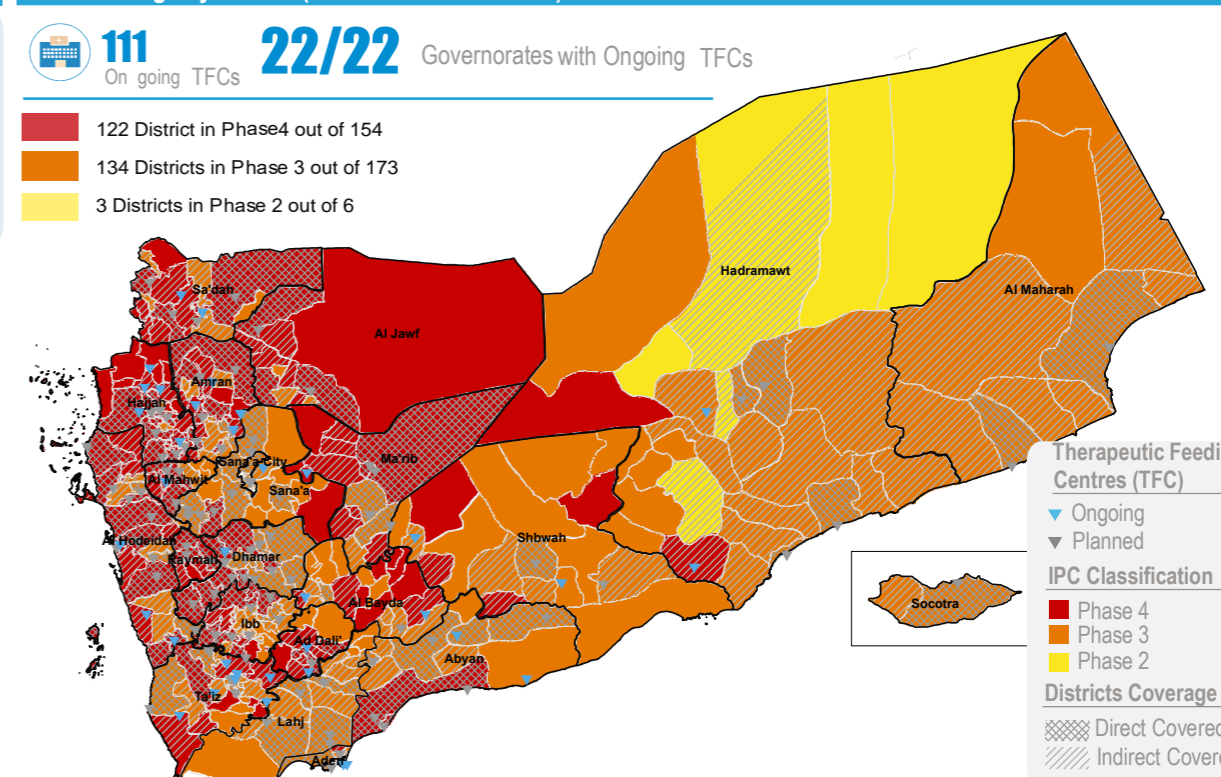
Oedema



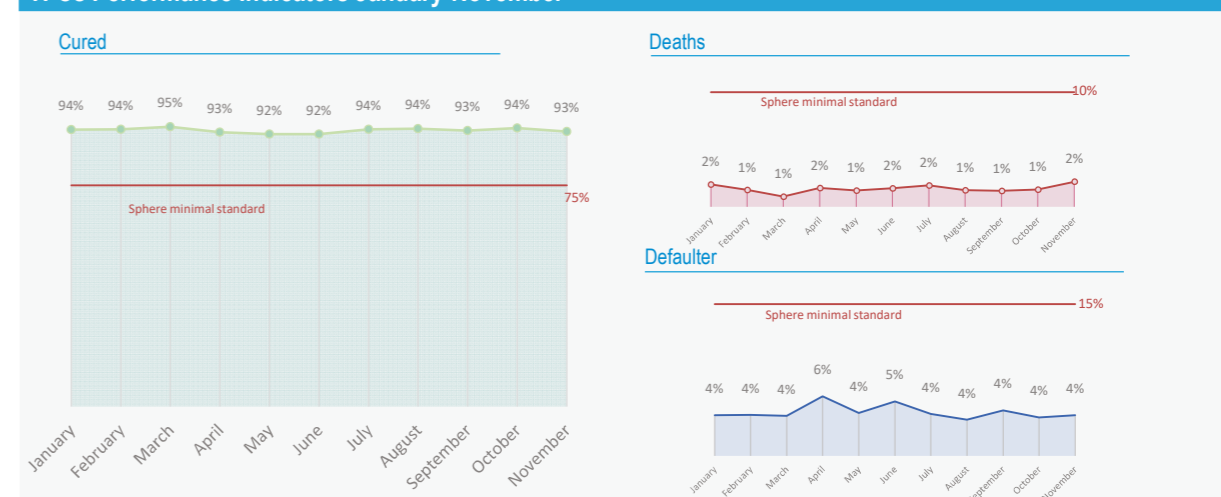
Relapse
