

YEMEN: Therapeutic Feeding Centres (TFC)

Service Utilization January-March

From January to March 2,920 children have received life-saving services in WHOsupported TFCs, of which 651 (22%) are children under 6 months. The quality of service is evidenced by the decrease in the default rate and death rate. In March, the cured rate reached 91%, the default rate was 6% and the death rate was only 2%.


Behind each child, a caregiver was counselled on IYCF best practices, 2,920 caregivers in total. Each caregiver received 10 counselling sessions per hospital stay. In 2020, 2,920 counselling sessions were conducted in TFCs. The increase of equitable access and utilization of quality preventive nutrition services in TFCs, such as IYCF counselling, is evidenced by the decrease in the relapse rate, at 3% on average per month, throughout







