



Behind each child, a caregiver was counselled on IYCF best practices, 9,999 caregivers in total. Each caregiver received 10 counselling sessions per hospital stay. In 2020, 99,990 counselling sessions were conducted in TFCs. The increase of equitable access and utilization of quality preventive nutrition services in TFCs, such as IYCF counselling, is evidenced by the decrease in the relapse rate, at 2% on average per month, throughout the 2020.





